An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is on the grounds of these events. The AED is located in ambulance parked in the unloading area.

The Rogue Valley Kennel Club, Inc. offers a New Champion Title Rosette for any dog that finishes a title at these shows.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-litling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge’s book, steward’s book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotti Romagnoli, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

NOTICE

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY AND JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

- Neither the Superintendent, nor RVKC, is able to cash checks.
- Rogue Valley Kennel Club, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.
- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these shows, nor be allowed on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these shows.

RV OVERNIGHT PARKING 2024

Overnight parking is available Friday, June 14 after 2:00 P.M. through Monday, June 17 at 9:00 A.M. No reservations will be issued for shorter periods of time, nor refunded if the owners decide to come later or leave earlier.

Price of reserved overnight RV parking for the entire show period is:

- \$150.00 with electric and water. Sewer may also be available.
 - \$120.00 for dry camping.
 - \$10.00 Tag-along vehicle fee is applicable with vehicle able to fit into the assigned space.
- If owner wishes to arrive earlier or stay longer, they must make a reservation directly with Josephine County Parks (541) 474-5285.

RV Parking has limited spaces with power, sewer and water hook-ups (at parking sites) as well as limited dry camping. Parking reservations should be made as early as possible and spaces will be pre-assigned on a first come, first served basis. If all spaces are not reserved prior to the show, open spaces will be assigned on the day of show at a price of \$160.00 for the whole show period payable by check upon arrival. As spaces will be pre-assigned, people wishing to park together MUST send their reservations together. There is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.

Vehicles over 40' total length or vehicles that will not fit in a 22' by 40' space will need to indicate that on the reservation to see if entire package will fit or whether additional space must be reserved. If your entire package will not fit in one space, you will need to buy additional space. Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched. Parking space in the RV area may not be given to day parkers.

Please note:

- ✓ No vehicle traffic in show limits during judging.
- ✓ No visitors may drive their cars into RV overnight area if they do not have a reservation.
- ✓ ALL RVs must have working fire extinguishers.
- ✓ All vehicles must be completely self-contained. No discharge of gray water or sanitary tanks.
- ✓ All RVs using generators must have a proper exhaust pipe venting away from dogs and people. No generators may be used from 11:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.
- ✓ No more than two vehicles per RV space, including tag along vehicle.
- ✓ All vehicles will be parked in the same direction as coordinated by parking staff.
- ✓ **NO parking or stopping is permitted on any grass area.**
- ✓ **Exhibitors are required to clean parking spaces prior to departure.**

Overnight and Day of Show parking are privileges of the Indian Mary Park and the Rogue Valley Kennel Club, Inc. These parties reserve the right to withdraw privileges, without returning parking or entry fees, from any person(s) who cannot abide by these rules or uses abusive language. Violators may be subject to event committee charges.

All parking is at your own risk. The Park or Club assumes NO responsibility or liability for damage or loss to vehicle, content or dogs. The Park or Club takes NO responsibility for vehicles towed in violation of parking laws or regulations and subject to actions of regulatory officers or agents. Vehicles illegally parked will be towed at owners expense. This may include parking on grass unless otherwise approved. The fire department has forbidden any vehicles in fire lanes or any unauthorized area.

Electricity cannot be guaranteed if technical problems occur. Electric cords cannot be piggy-backed onto another rig that is plugged into Park electricity. NO CORDS can be run across any sidewalks, walkways or fire lanes. Any violators will be disconnected immediately.

Parking form and payment must have been received by May 30, 2024. No refunds will be issued after that date.

ROGUE VALLEY KENNEL CLUB, INC. COVID-19 PLAN

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.
